

**Civilian Fire Inspector

This position is responsible for delivering fire prevention activities. Work involves enforcing all codes, laws and ordinances pertaining to fire and life safety of public buildings, events, temporary structures and places of assembly that may occur in the City; reviewing construction, alarm, detection, and other fire suppression system plans for code compliance and conducting public education activities; coordinates and manages the fire department pre-fire planning program, including the collection, analysis and entry of building information for the development of pre-fire plans for new and existing buildings. The incumbent works under the general supervision of the Fire Protection Engineer and Deputy Fire Chief. This position requires experience in fire prevention activities, supplemented by technical training beyond the high school level in fire science technology, loss prevention and control or related field, or any equivalent combination of experience and training. Candidates must have the ability to obtain and maintain certification as a fire inspector and building inspector.
